Track Stars

Track Stars has been a huge success with the younger grades! We are now using an electronic scanner to track laps using a program called EZ-scan. It's downloaded to an iPad/tablet and the kids have badges with barcodes that get scanned every lap. 12 laps = 1 mile and every mile the kids get a bead. There was a suggestion to turn track stars into a fundraiser. A person could pledge a \$1.00 for every mile ran. We could create a wall of fame by the cafeteria to highlight the runners with the most miles.

Title 1 Update

Principal Ernie Rascon gave a presentation about Hansen's Title 1 Status. Hansen's designation as a Title 1 school allows us to receive federal dollars that are first allocated to the state, then passed on to each district, and then to eligible schools. Jeni Erikson's position is funded 50% by Title 1 and 50% Lap.
